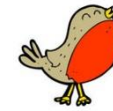
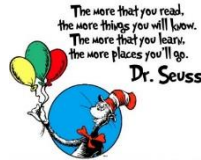


Year 1 - The Robin's Homework



For homework this year your child **needs** to (this homework isn't optional):

Read at home regularly. Reading **most nights** (even for five minutes) will help your child to become the best reader they can be!



Practice the weekly spellings from their **BLUE** spelling book. Your child will have a spelling test every **Friday** morning based on these spellings only.

Practice reading and writing phonic word spellings from their **RED** phonics books.

Practice reading the tricky words (words that can't be sounded out using phonics) from their **tricky word tin**.



For maths homework this term we would like the children to focus on basic number skills e.g.
Number bonds to 10, 20 or 100
Number patterns e.g. If I know that $6+4 = 10$ I also know $4+6 = 10$, $10 - 6 = 4$ $10 - 4 = 6$ $16 + 4 = 20$
Counting in 2's, 5's and 10's
Recognising the place value of a 2 digit number e.g. 23 has 2 tens and 3 ones
