14/9/18	26/9/18	Our class text 'Journey to Jo'burg' is set in South Africa. Make a tourist information leaflet about what South Africa has to offer!
28/9/18	10/10/18	Get creative and design your own African Safari Park. You can design it by hand or use a computer but make sure it is eye-catching and exciting!
12/10/18	24/10/18	Imagine you are in the middle of an African Safari/plain. Write a postcard home describing what you can see, hear, touch, smell and even taste!
26/10/18	7/11/18	In topic we are learning about the Kingdom of Benin, which nowadays is found in Nigeria. Write a report about life in Nigeria today - ask Miss Casley for a sheet or create your own!
9/11/18	21/11/18	Create your own animal that could survive in the African desert. Label the features that you have chosen for the animal to help it survive and don't forget to give it a name.
23/11/18	5/12/18	Design a poster to encourage people to donate to an African charity. Research what African charities currently exist and choose one for your poster.
7/12/18	19/12/18	Produce a fact file on an African animal of your choice. Where is its habitat? What does it eat? What does it look like?
